### SUBSCRIPTIONS - Legal obligation

As mentioned at last year's AGM, we retendered for the Gardens maintenance contract. To cover the increased costs in maintaining the Gardens, proposed subscriptions are £160 Early Bird and £180 Standard rate

The Gardens are owned collectively. All in 1–19 Learmonth Gardens, 1–23 South Learmonth Gardens, 12 Learmonth Gardens Lane and 1A Learmonth Place are owners and have a legal obligation to maintain the Gardens.

All subscriptions are **payable by 31 August 2024**. The Early Bird discount applies before 31 July. For anyone moving, the owner of the property on 31 August is liable for the full amount.

#### GARDENS MAINTENANCE UPDATE

We went out to tender for the Gardens' maintenance at the end of last year. Several contractors were approached, three expressed interested and two provided quotations. After the interviews, Blackhall Gardens Services were awarded the five-year contract from 2024 to 2029.

We will continue to focus on managing the Gardens to create an attractive, peaceful space for all residents to enjoy and to follow a sustainable maintenance strategy that supports the diversity of plants and wildlife.

# **VOLUNTEER WORK PARTY**

A huge thank you to those who help in the Gardens by tidying leaf and twig litter, watering trees, maintaining the planting on the slopes, and keeping the benches clean and in good repair.

We are planning on having a volunteer work party in July – so get your trowels out! This involves a friendly bunch of residents getting together to do a couple of hours of gardening, followed by some well-earned refreshments.

# **BARBEQUES, BALL GAMES AND GUIDELINES**

Now that the warmer(?) months are approaching, please note that we have two designated stone-slab barbeque areas on the walls – one opposite Learmonth Place and the other opposite 13 Learmonth Gardens. Please don't put barbeques on the grass, paths or tree stumps.

'The Gardens are not suitable for games played by adults and older children – these are prohibited because of the potential for damage to shrubs and trees, cars, etc. that might result. All ball games involving a 'hard' ball – including football, bat-and-ball, tennis, cricket – are not allowed. All ball games played by younger children – involving only soft balls – should be monitored by responsible adults.'

We are fortunate to have two acres of beautiful mature woodland gardens on our doorstep for all to enjoy. Please respect the trees, shrubberies and your fellow neighbours.

Please review the Gardens Guidelines.

#### WILDLIFE AND TREES UPDATE

All the trees in the Gardens are protected by a Tree Preservation Order and any work requires planning permission.

Last year's annual tree survey recommended removal of a Wild Cherry, the Weeping Willow and a Whitebeam. This has now been implemented, and three new trees have been planted: a Sessile Oak, a Swedish Whitebeam (opposite No. 15LG) and a Royal Burgundy Cherry, which has had beautiful blossom this year.

We are also closely monitoring the other Cherries as they have very sparse crowns. We will mulch these trees and the other new trees later this month.

We will leave the new Beech by Comely Bank Avenue, which was badly ring-barked by hungry squirrel kits in 2022, for another year. Although this tree is unlikely to survive, it has leaves on the lower branches, so we are going to give it another chance!

The Common-Spotted Orchids are going to start emerging in our wildflower meadow soon. Last year we had 24! As normal, the orchids will be clearly marked with sticks, so please avoid them. The range of wildflowers has increased dramatically since we started managing the western side for wildlife, providing a huge boost to pollinators, birds and mammals.
